BY BUS: The following bus routes all stop near to the Business Design Centre in Upper Street:
4, 19, 30, 73, 43, 38, 56, and 341.

BY CAR: Easy access from the City and West End. Upper Street forms part of the A1.

BY RAIL: Euston and Kings Cross Stations are a short distance away.

BY UNDERGROUND: A regular underground train service (Northern line) runs to and from the Angel Station, which is a two minute walk from the Centre. Alternatively, Highbury & Islington Station (Victoria Line) is a fifteen minute walk from the Centre.

CONGESTION CHARGE

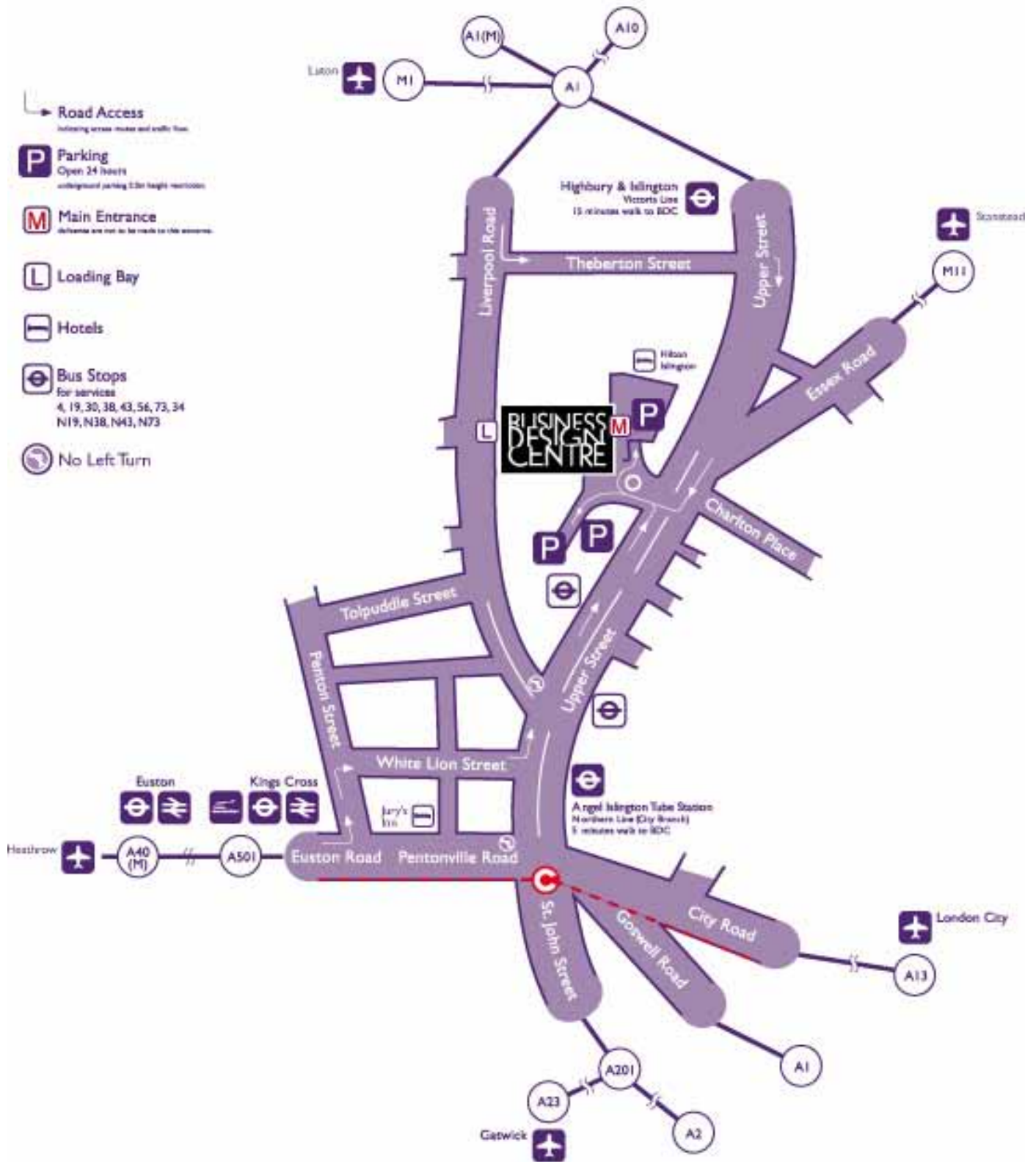
The Business Design Centre falls just outside the Central London Congestion charge boundary. Some routes to the Centre will be affected by the charge, which has been set at £8.00 applying from 0700 to 1830 hours during Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays).
